HOW DO I GET THERE?

From the San Francisco Airport

Take the Marin Airporter to Larkspur Landing, where you will need to take a cab to the SFTS campus. Buses depart SF Airport on the half hour, beginning at 5 a.m., ending at midnight. Fare is approximately \$15 one way. More information at www.marinairporter.com or call the Larkspur Terminal at 415.461.4222.

From Oakland Airport

Take the Sonoma County Airport Express to downtown San Rafael, Third and Heatherton. Buses leave Oakland Airport every two hours, starting at 6 a.m. and ending at midnight. Fare is approximately \$16 one way. For more information, www.airportexpressinc.com or 800.327.2024. Golden Gate Transit bus #20 "San Francisco" operates from the San Rafael Transit Center on Third and Heatherton to Bolinas and Sir Francis Drake, which is three blocks from campus. The fare is about \$1.50. Taxi service is also available from the San Rafael Transit Center.

From Both Airports - Marin Door to Door

Marin Door to Door is a van service directly from S.F. Airport or Oakland Airport to the seminary. It operates daily from about 4 a.m. until 1 a.m. Reservations are required 24 hours in advance at 800.540.4815. The fare from S.F. Airport is \$34; \$12 each additional person. The fare from Oakland is \$50 with \$12 for each additional person.

Driving Directions

From South - Take Hwy. 101 north from Golden Gate Bridge to San Anselmo exit. Take Sir Francis Drake Blvd. approximately three miles; left on Bolinas Ave.; Two blocks to Kensington Road; Right into seminary entrance.

From East - Take Hwy 580 across Richmond-San Rafael Bridge. Take Sir Francis Drake Blvd. exit and stay on this past the Hwy. 101 underpass. Go approximately three miles and follow above directions.
